Dr. Kuhl’s recent work has focused on understanding the physical, emotional and spiritual impact on caregivers as they care for patients/residents who are dying, suffering or experiencing a crisis. His workshop will help participants learn how to:

- Understand how to sustain health care providers in the workplace
- inspire vocational satisfaction, and revitalize compassion
- explore the cost of being in the presence of suffering
- strengthen relationships among care teams and practitioners
- promote interdisciplinary respect
- enhance psychological and spiritual well-being

David is the Director of the Centre for Practitioner Renewal (CPR) and an Associate Professor for the Department of Family Practice, Faculty of Medicine at the University of British Columbia. He was the physician leader for palliative care at Providence Health Care, BC. As the Director of CPR, he is working to combine his interests in medicine and psychology to develop a program of service, education and research to sustain health care providers in the workplace. He has written two books, *What Dying People Want: Practical Wisdom for the End-of-Life* and *Facing Death Embracing Life, Understanding What Dying People Want.*
